Thema: Decoding Phonetic Transcriptions					

Now that you learned how to handle dictionaries correctly there is one more step to make you independent when you want to look up new words.

The International Phonetic Alphabet (IPA) was developed to help language learners pronounce unknown words correctly. The phonetic transcriptions are given in brackets [] behind each dictionary entry.

Please open **Green Line 4 at page 145**. There, you'll find an overview of all the sounds. Some letters look quite similar to the normal alphabet that we know, some are different and have to be remembered.

- **Task 1:** Take turns with your partner and pronounce every sound in the list. Take notes of the ones that are not so easy to remember.
